### Dates

### Ballet Exams

The last push is now on before the ballet exams at the beginning of February. Please ensure that your child/ren attend all lessons from now on to give them the confidence they need to reach their potential.

All ballet exams and mocks will be held at Bohunt School, F Block in the dance studio. Please enter the building (A Block) via the side door where the staircase is and wait in the drama hall (next to the toilets). If you are unsure as to where this is please ask in advance as exams cannot be disturbed by people entering the studio at incorrect times.

Remember the importance of the mock exam and ensure that you arrive 30 minutes before your time slot with your child's hair already in a ballet bun. All students require ribbon on ballet shoes. This is available from Anne at £1/m.

**Ballet exam fees are now due** – your exam invoice will be sent separately to your normal dance invoice and fees need to be paid to **Dancing Dosh**. BACS details of this account will be on your exam invoice.
