Summer School

- Time is flying past and the Summer Holidays are rapidly approaching. Ballet training should be continued through the holidays as much as possible to ensure that exam work is not compromised and standards are maintained.
- Students from Standard 1 through all grades to Intermediate Foundation will be considered for ballet exams in Spring 2018.

- Only students with good attendance will be entered for exams as it is the repetitive training
 alongside good knowledge of terminology and clean execution of steps that will enable your
 child/ren to reach the standard required.
- If your child has only recently started ballet they may not reach the required standard in time if entering for higher grades; but they will be ready for future exam entry. All student progress will be monitored closely and every effort made to help them reach their targets.
